Enthymeme: We should not let the Persians invade Egypt because, in the past, the Persians did not invade Greece until they had invaded Egypt.

Possibility: The current Athenian state policy is to pursue peace. This means that either A) instead of abiding by their *specific* kind of non-violent peace, the state might be reasoned into adopting a more *general* kind of peace where violence in the name of self-defence is allowed, or B) we Greeks desire peace, which means peace is possible, which means there must be a way for us to keep the Persians from invading, or C)..., etc.

Paradigm: Darius did not invade Greece until he had taken Egypt. And Darius' son Xerxes did not invade Greece until he had taken Egypt.

Degree of Magnitude: If we let the Persians invade Egypt, we will be invaded too. This means our homes will be destroyed and looted and we will become slaves. So yeah, this argument is important...


SOURCE A: The tweet below contains United Airlines' response to an incident on one of its overbooked flights. The staff onboard the plane demanded that David Dao, a 69 year-old doctor, leave the plane. He refused, and United called security to forcibly remove Dr. Dao from his seat. Other passengers used their phones to record the incident, which culminated in the security team beating Dr. Dao and dragging him off the plane. Videos of the incident went viral and caused a firestorm in news networks around the globe. The CEO of United Airlines wrote this message to address the situation and reassure his customers that United Airlines was a company with integrity. But his message caused another firestorm on social media.



United CEO response to United Express Flight 3411.

This is an upsetting event to all of us here at United. I apologize for having to re-accommodate these customers. Our team is moving with a sense of urgency to work with the authorities and conduct our own detailed review of what happened. We are also reaching out to this passenger to talk directly to him and further address and resolve this situation.


SOURCE B: The text below is from a speech former Prime Minister Stephen Harper delivered in 2015 to the Jewish Community Council of Montreal, following the passing of Bill C-51 (also known as the Anti-Terrorism Act). The bill has come under criticism from civil liberties groups for the threat it poses to individual rights (as outlined in the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms) and for its unspecific language, which grants sweeping powers to police forces.

"Friends, we know that evil comes in many forms, and reinvents itself time and again...Those who hate democracy and freedom, tolerance and openness have been plotting attacks against Western nations, beginning with Israel, for decades, seeking to destroy our rare and precious way of life.

The Anti-Terrorism Act 2015 contains a range of measures to ensure that our police and security agencies have the modern tools they need to meet evolving threats and keep us safe, by giving them the authority to stop planned attacks, to allow them to share information, to get threats quickly off our streets, to criminalize the promotion of terrorism, and to prevent terrorists from travelling and recruiting others.

We have joined this international mission because it is not merely in the wider interests of the global community; we do this because it is in Canada's national interest. Canadians know that we cannot 'opt-out' of the world."

SOURCE C: The Reddit comment below is Electronic Arts' response to the criticism it faced after the launch of their video game, *Star Wars Battlefront II*. The game came under fire from reviewers and the Battlefront community for its "pay to win" pricing structure. The game gave the player two options for accessing gameplay enhancements and major characters: 1) spend dozens of hours accumulating points and levelling up, or 2) pay real money. Within 24 hours this comment became the most downvoted comment in Reddit history. It is now listed in the Guinness World Record book for 2020.

Bonus Activity: Wildfires PR Statement

Wildfires are spreading across California and the U.S. Federal government is under fire for their lack of response and their withholding of funds. Local Californians are upset that the president took so long to respond to the situation. And when he finally did respond, Californians had even more reason to be angry. The president blamed California state officials for failing to manage the threat.

The facts:

- 1) The fires are raging in national parks and forest areas that are under federal control
- 2) 100 people have perished in the fire
- 3) Two mountain towns have been burned to the ground.
- 4) Two million people have evacuated their homes and are living in make-shift camps and sports venues.
- 5) The red cross is trying to help the displaced but they are financially strapped and don't have the manpower to help everyone.
- 6) People who live in the cities (San Francisco Bay Area and L.A.) have to wear masks because air pollution levels are at record highs.
- 7) People with lung problems have been asked to stay indoors.
- 8) There's a horrific image of a family of burned corpses inside a burned house. The family did not receive warning that a fire was approaching because their house was not within hearing range of the local warning siren. The image is circulating through social media platforms and news networks.
